Gemini & other older Alaris Pumps – obsolescence & upgrade path

As part of our ongoing development, CareFusion's manufacturing sites constantly review their product portfolio to ensure that they meet the latest standards, support the customer's ongoing environments, and ensure that our service exceeds expectations.

As a product progresses through its life cycle, it eventually matures to the end-of-life stage and due to a combination of factors such as technological advances, low demand, unattainable supply of components the product becomes uneconomical to manufacture and the supply chain unreliable.

It is with regret that the **Gemini family of infusion pumps** is approaching the end-of-life stage and CareFusion has prepared an obsolescence plan as below:

Current status of Gemini spare parts and consumables:

- Spare Parts: If we have stock to December 2013, we will supply and repair as quoted but can no longer source already out of stock parts with the manufacturer.
- Importantly the Gemini Infusion sets will not end at December 2013 as they are also used on the Alaris System pumps. We hope this makes it easy to transition to new infusion equipment.

As a reminder, the **following older Alaris pumps** have also reached their end-of-life stage.

As we have communicated previously over the last 18 months several of our very early devices have come to their end of life; please see a table below summarising these.
